LEADER Let's take a moment to reflect upon our struggles and sins, before we confess our sins to almighty God.

TAKE A MINUTE OF SILENCE

ALL *Most merciful God, we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed by what we have done, and by*

what we have left undone. We have not loved you with our whole heart; we have not loved our neighbors as ourselves. We are truly sorry and we humbly repent for the sake of your Son Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may delight in your will, and walk in your ways, to the glory of your Name. Amen.

LEADER Knowing that it is Jesus Christ who lifts you up out of your sins, please stand to receive these words of assurance:

Almighty Father, in your great love you gave your dearly beloved Son to die for us: grant that through his cross our sins may be put away, and remembered no more against us, and that, cleansed by his

daily, and follow him
in newness of life,
until we come to his
everlasting kingdom;
through your Son
Jesus Christ our Lord.
